SHREVEPORT, LA - Memorial services for Dr. Thomas A. Glass, Jr. will be held at 11:00 a.m. Wednesday, June 18, 2003, at Osborn Funeral Home. Officiating will be Dr. Pat Day. He served as a Lieutenant Commander in the Navy Medical Corps in the South Pacific during World War II. Dr. Glass practiced medicine in Shreveport at Willis-Knighton Medical Center for over 60 years, delivering thousands of babies into this world as an Obstetrician/Gynecologist.

Dr. Glass enjoyed spending his time with his family watching and attending sporting events and taking trips to Lake Greeson. Most recently, at age 88, Dr. Glass took his entire family to Maui to revisit favorite places he and his wife enjoyed on their frequent trips to Hawaii.
